

Directorate of Enforcement (ED), Lucknow Zonal Office has provisionally attached immovable properties worth Rs. 3.21 Crore belonging to Rampal Singh, Ex. Vice Chancellor, Chaudhary Charan Singh University (CCSU), Meerut and his Trust RP Singh Charitable Trust under the provisions of Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002. The properties attached are in the form of institutional land and two storey residential building situated in Badayun and Bareilly districts of UP, respectively.

ED initiated investigation on the basis of FIR registered by UP Vigilance, Meerut Sector against Dr. Rampal Singh, Ex. Vice Chancellor, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut (formerly Meerut University) and others. Vigilance Department, Govt of UP had conducted independent enquiry against Dr. Rampal Singh and submitted its report based on which he was found guilty of various irregularities, during the period 2003 to 2005. As per the enquiry report of Vigilance Department of UP, various allegations have been levelled against Dr. Rampal Singh and others viz. irregularities in conducting of CPMT (Combined Pre-Medical Test) Entrance Exam-2004, appointment of daily wage workers in CCS University Meerut and awarding affiliation to the colleges violating several procedures and norms of the Universities. He has been charged guilty of various irregularities during his tenure as Vice Chancellor of Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut (UP).

ED investigation revealed that Dr Rampal Singh, in collusion with other senior executives of the CCS University indulged in unlawful activities, violating several procedures and norms of the Universities, causing wrongful loss to the tune of Rs 3.64 Crore to the government and acquiring various properties during the offence period. Properties attached have been acquired during and just after the offence period and the total value stands at 3.21 Crore.

Further investigation is under progress.
